Employees of Hudsonville Public Schools have the option to make charitable contributions to the Hudsonville Education Foundation through the automatic payroll deduction program, direct contributions, and planned giving options.

By participating in the automatic payroll deduction program, employees can easily contribute to the Hudsonville Education Endowment Fund. This fund is held at the Community Foundation Holland/Zeeland and ensures that donations have a lasting impact on education, benefiting both current and future generations of students.

The designated amount is automatically deducted from the employee's bi-weekly paycheck, with a minimum of \$1 per pay period. These contributions are deducted after payroll taxes and may be eligible for tax deductions as permitted by the IRS. Payroll deductions will continue until the payroll office is notified of any changes or termination.

Direct contributions to the Hudsonville Education Foundation General Fund provides crucial funding for ongoing programming, allowing resources to be directed to where they are needed the most. Regardless of the fund, every charitable gift supports education for students of Hudsonville Public Schools.
