Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame

1. The Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame is a distinct and high honor reserved for alumni who have made extraordinary achievements in their respective fields and/or community following graduation from Hudsonville Public Schools.
2. High school academic performance including grades and/or test scores are not a determining factor in recipient criteria or selection.
3. In addition to solicited nominations from the public, a Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame Committee will be formed to research and build a list of proposed candidates.
4. Nominations and candidates not selected to receive an award during a particular year will be carried over into subsequent years for consideration.
5. All inductees must be graduates of Hudsonville Public Schools or will have received an honorary diploma from the Hudsonville Public Schools Board of Education.
6. A Lifetime Legacy award category will be established for non-graduates who are deemed worthy of recognition for their contributions to Hudsonville Public School/community.
7. Inductee attendance at the Eagles of Excellence Gala is highly encouraged and will be taken into consideration during the review process.

CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

Cultural/Performing Arts – This individual is a graduate of HPS and recognized for achievements in the cultural, visual, or performing arts and/or contributions to the promotion of cultural activities on a local, state, national, or global level.

Career accomplishments (This can include military recognition) – This individual is a graduate of HPS and recognized for achievement in his or her profession which has resulted in a direct and significant impact in his or her field. The nominee has demonstrated unique talents and/or accomplishments.

Service to Hudsonville Public Schools/Community – This individual is a graduate of HPS and recognized for service to the Hudsonville Public Schools or to community or society by sustained example or contribution, and by serving as a major influence in the lives of Hudsonville students or in the community/society through acts of leadership. Hudsonville High School graduation is not a requirement in this category.
